Pushing Print are pleased to announce a series of bursary awards.

9 awards are available to apply for as follows:

- **2 x £500 Exhibition Bursaries**

EXHIBITION BURSARIES

These two awards of £500 each are for exhibitions of printmaking to take place at Pie Factory Gallery, Margate during 2016. They are open to individuals or groups. The Pie Factory has two exhibition spaces - Pie Factory Gallery; a large venue with 4 connected spaces Gallery 7; a small single space

These two awards are open to printmakers and artists whose work relates to printmaking in some way. Recent graduates are eligible to apply. These bursaries are not open to past or current members of Pushing Print committee.

The bursary will cover the venue hire cost of either £250 for a week at Pie Factory Gallery plus £250 towards other exhibition costs, or £400 for a month at Gallery 7 plus £100 towards other exhibition costs. The exhibitions must be relevant to printmaking.

Recipients of these two awards will be responsible for the hire, organisation, promotion, delivery and manning of these two exhibitions. Pushing Print will pay the venue hire costs direct to Pie Factory CIC and the remaining bursary to the recipient.

Recipients will be required to

- use the Pushing Print logo on all publicity material and acknowledge Pushing Print in any literature or press release.
- Hold their exhibition during 2016
- Provide Pushing Print with photographs on completion of the exhibitions and a blog post for the website

To apply for a £500 Exhibition Bursary email your proposal on no more than one side of A4 (approx. 500 words) outlining

- your idea for your exhibition
- how this award will help develop your practise
- your budget

Printmaking Bursaries

These 7 awards are aimed at artists who have an idea but need the money to make it happen. They can be used for a variety of things but must be related to printmaking

For example

- to pay for a course or workshop
- for the design and build of a website
- to go and see an exhibition
- research costs
- materials for a project
- exhibition costs
- as match funding towards a larger project

These bursary awards are open to printmakers, artists whose work relates to printmaking in some way, or artists who wish to develop their knowledge of or skills of printmaking. Recent graduates and undergraduates are eligible to apply. These bursaries are not open to past or current members of Pushing Print committee.

Recipients of these awards will be responsible for the development and delivery of their idea/project

Recipients will be required to

- use the Pushing Print logo on all publicity material and acknowledge Pushing Print in any literature or press release.
- Begin their project no earlier than Sept 2015 and complete by Dec 31st 2016
- Provide Pushing Print with photographs on completion and a blog post for the website

To apply for one of the Printmaking Bursaries

- send a proposal on no more than one side of A4 (approx. 500 words) outlining your idea/project/what you would like to do
- how this award will help develop your practise
- your budget
